
Hewitt



During the 2018/19 season, the Hewitt Cup will be run again as an internal club competition with a single league and an "all play all" format

Hewitt games will be ungraded, unless both parties agree before commencement that it be graded

All club members are eligible to participate with late entries added if necessary BUT I initially included everyone unless they told me that they didn't want to play

ONCE YOU HAVE FOUR SCORES on the board, a second game may be played against the same opponent

Where a second game is played, colours should be reversed (but if you can't remember, it doesn't invalidate the game to choose colours by the normal means)

At the end of the competition (results REPORTED to me by 16th August) the person with the most points wins; the person with the next highest score (unless they have played more than twice for the first team) will win the Leyn Cup Four points will be awarded for a win, two points for a draw, one for a loss ... easier than 1, 0.5 and 0.25!

Results must be notified to me (Charles) as soon as possible by both players (if you want any points!) and to Gary if the game is to be graded

Neither player will be awarded any points for unplayed games.

Rate of play shall be whatever you agree (minimum 30, maximum 80 minutes for all moves)

DEFAULT (if you can't agree) rates of play are 80 mins if a match is taking place or 30 mins if NO match is taking place

Normal rules of chess apply to the conduct of games; quick-play rules e.g. taking a king left in check, do not apply.
